Mark 5:1-13

They went across the lake to the region of the Gerasenes. When Jesus got out of the boat, a man with an impure spirit came from the tombs to meet him. This man lived in the tombs and no one could bind him anymore, not even with a chain. For he had often been chained hand and foot but he tore the chains apart and broke the irons on his feet. No one was strong enough to subdue him. Night and day among the tombs and in the hills he would cry out and cut himself with stones. When he saw Jesus from a distance, he ran and fell on his knees in front of him. He shouted at the top of his voice, "What do you want with me, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? In God's name don't torture me!" For Jesus had said to him, "Come out of this man, you impure spirit!" Then Jesus asked him, "What is your name?" "My name is Legion," he replied, "for we are many." And he begged Jesus again and again not to send them out of the area. A large herd of pigs was feeding on the nearby hillside. The demons begged Jesus, "Send us among the pigs, allow us to go into them." He gave them permission and the impure spirits came out and went into the pigs. The herd, about two thousand in number, rushed down the steep bank into the lake and were drowned.

- In this scripture we can see that the Word has the ability to change a city
- The Word of God has the ability to change your life
- The Word of God has the power to break every negative thing in your life
- The Word of God has the ability to make you grow and to push you forward

Psalm 119:9-16

How can a young person stay on the path of purity? By living according to your word. I seek you with all my heart, do not let me stray from your commands. I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.-Praise be to you, LORD, teach me your decrees.-With my lips I recount all the laws that come from your mouth.-I rejoice in following your statutes as one rejoices in great riches.-I meditate on your precepts and consider your ways.-I delight in your decrees, I will not neglect your word.

- Allow the Word of God to impact and influence you
- God can only move if you allow Him

Galatians 6:7-9

Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows. Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction, whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life. Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.

- What you sow you will reap. If you sow the right seed in your life you will go forward
- Don't give attention to the wrong seeds that you have sown in the past, in due time you will start to reap the good fruit of the good seed that you started to sow
- Don't be discouraged by the enemy and his distractions
- Sow the right seed, in due time it will come to pass. Continue to sow the right seed

Genesis 8:22

"As long as the earth endures, seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, summer and winter, day and night will never cease."

- If you did not sow anything you cannot expect to reap a harvest
- Another problem with people is that they sow today and want to reap tomorrow but it does not work that way
- The seed that is sown in your life will definitely grow
- God honours His Word
- Where are you sowing seeds?
- First you need to sow the Word of God into your spirit
- Speak the Word of God into your situations
- What are you sowing?
- What are you allowing to influence you?
- Don't allow distractions in your life. If that influence is greater than the Word of God you will be ruled by the flesh. Your flesh will get you into trouble
- Sow the Word of God into your spirit
- That will keep you growing and going forward
- It doesn't matter where you are, keep sowing

Romans 10:8-10

But what does it say? "The word is near you, it is in your mouth and in your heart," that is, the message concerning faith that we proclaim.-If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.-For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.

- The Word need to be in your heart and mouth
- We need to believe the Word that we carry in our hearts
- God honours His Word and He will cause it to happen
- Nothing is impossible for God

Romans 10:17

Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message and the message is heard through the word about Christ.

- There is so much power that is in the Word

The Word of God

Sow the seeds into your spirit and into your heart and you will begin to grow

1. The Word of God has integrity

Numbers 23:19

God is not human, that he should lie, not a human being, that he should change his mind. Does he speak and then not act? Does he promise and not fulfill?

- God's nature is that of integrity
- It is impossible for God to lie
- When God says something He will do it

2. The Word of God is the highest form of truth

John 17:17

Sanctify them by the truth, your word is truth.

- We can always trust God and take Him at His Word
- We have a choice to believe God's Word over the facts
- Facts can be true but they are not the highest truth, God's Word is
- The facts in your life can prove that you are poor but that is not the highest truth
- What God says supersedes any other facts in your life
- God's Word is the final authority. It carries power

3. The Word of God is prophetic

2 Peter 1:19

We also have the prophetic message as something completely reliable and you will do well to pay attention to it, as to a light shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts.

- The Word is the light that pushes the darkness away
- As you speak the Word it will become prophetic
- The Word of God can change things and challenges in your life
- When you confess the Word over your life, there will come a day when the Word of God will rise in you as the light in the darkness and push out the problems
- The doors will open in your life
- Sow the seeds of the Word in your life on a daily basis
- God watches over His own Word and will perform that what He has said

4. The Word of God will stand forever

1 Peter 1:25

...but the word of the Lord endures forever." And this is the word that was preached to you.

John 6:63

The Spirit gives life, the flesh counts for nothing. The words I have spoken to you—they are full of the Spirit and life.

- The Spirit gives life
- The Spirit does not need an upgrade, the Word is alive
- The Word will destroy anything negative in your life
- It has the power to produce growth
- Put the Word of God in your spirit

5. The Word is an incorruptible seed

1 Peter 1:23

For you have been born again, not of perishable seed but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God.

- When God touches you, it is not only for a moment
- His Word is not just a temporary fix it is a permanent change
- The Word of God cannot be corrupted
- The Word of God will succeed

6. The Word of God is profitable

2 Timothy 3:16

All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness,

- The most profitable possession in life is to put His Word in your heart
- Invest in yourself by investing the Word of God in your spirit
- We can be, what we have been called to be

7. The Word of God is a sword

Ephesians 6:17

Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

- This is your weapon in the spirit
- Apply the word in every area of your life

Hebrews 4:12

For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow, it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.

- The Word cannot just sit on the table we need to use the Word of God
- The Word needs to be in your mouth
- The Word of God needs to be in your spirit
- Take up your responsibility in your life
- We need to show up before the Lord
- We need to take ourselves further with God
- Become a person of faith. Stir up your faith. Be real with God
- Apply God's Word in your life
- Meditate on the Word, ask God what you must do
- In due season your harvest will come

8. The Word is like a mirror

James 1:22-25

Do not merely listen to the word and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says. Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like someone who looks at his face in a mirror and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like. But whoever looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom and continues in it—not forgetting what they have heard but doing it—they will be blessed in what they do.

- A mirror is only reflecting what is looking into it
- When you look into the Word of God, it will give you a picture of who you are, it will show you what is wrong but it will show you what you need to do to change it
- Don't look into the Word of God and do nothing. Apply the Word that you received and put it into your life. Apply the Word first into your own life
- What is God saying to you?
- God wants to shape your life
- The Word is first for the application in your life
- Be serious about the Word of God

9. The Word is Jesus

John 1:1-5

In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through him all things were made, without him nothing was made that has been made. In him was life and that life was the light of all mankind. The light shines in the darkness and the darkness has not overcome it.

John 1:14

The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

- Every time you receive the Word you receive Jesus
- The Word reveals Jesus to us
- In the parable of the seed, the sower has come to sow the seed
- Jesus is the sower, the enemy does not want you to put the Spirit in your life
- Live out the Word of God
- Get the Word in your spirit
- You will be influential because you are influenced
- Get into the Word of the Lord
- Get a Word from God, ask God to give you a fresh Word
- Stand on this fresh Word of God
