- We are going up to worship the King
 - In the midst of circumstances we will praise Him
 - There is power and victory in His name
 - He deserves all our worship and praise
 - No spirit of fear will keep us back
 - We release victory
 - There is no shame or guilt over any person. We break every barrier that is keeping us back
 - We are sons and daughters of the most high God

- God is establishing His throne in the midst of His people
 - We are held in the hands of God
 - God has good plans for us. God wants to prosper us in every area of our lives
 - Our worship needs to be filled with complete trust in Him. Do not put your trust in money, work or anything but Him. He wants to take us into a prosperous future
 - No matter what you are going through or what circumstances you are facing, trust in Him
 - Receive His good plan for your life
 - He is the God that restores and heal
 - God wants to prosper you spiritually, people will breakthrough
 - Our intimacy with God need to increase
 - We need to have the mind of Christ
 - We will be prosperous in our bodies, no sickness or disease. We will be prosperous in our relationships between husband and wife, parents and children, people around you, etc.
 - He wants to bestow goodness and mercy on every life

Word

- God is a good God
- His goodness is not dependent on where you are at in your personal life or circumstances
- God is always good, whether you are on top of the mountain or in the valley of your life
- There is something that we need to do to activate His goodness in our lives
- God never withholds His goodness
- He loves everyone even the sinners but He has a special place in His heart for His children
- The Word of God says that it is the goodness of God that leads us to repentance
- He has good plans and a great future for us. He holds us in the palm of His hand
- The way that we respond in our hearts is important to God. God is looking for a response from His children because He wants to bestow goodness upon our lives
- We are so programmed with negativity that we put God in the same category as you are
- In Genesis 22 we read that Abraham was thrown a curveball in life. Many times in our lives we are confronted with a curveball
- It is part of the steppingstones to your good future
- Sometimes God is the author of that curveball and many times it can be something else that is the author of that curveball but God allows it as it many times push us in the right direction for our future
- God has a great future for you

- The curveball will prepare you and take you to your future
- God is looking for a certain response so that He can release the goodness over your life

Genesis 22:5

And Abraham said to his young men, "Stay here with the donkey, the lad and I will go yonder and worship and we will come back to you."

Genesis 22:10-14

And Abraham stretched out his hand and took the knife to slay his son. But the Angel of the Lord called to him from heaven and said, "Abraham, Abraham!" So he said, "Here I am." And He said, "Do not lay your hand on the lad or do anything to him, for now I know that you fear God, since you have not withheld your son, your only son, from Me." Then Abraham lifted his eyes and looked and there behind him was a ram caught in a thicket by its horns. So Abraham went and took the ram and offered it up for a burnt offering instead of his son. And Abraham called the name of the place, The-Lord-Will-Provide, as it is said to this day, "In the Mount of the Lord it shall be provided."

- At times we are confronted with a curveball as Abraham were. The curveball does not determine your future
- God is in control and He has a good future in store for you
- The worst mistake that we can make is to respond to the curveball of life with murmuring and negativity
- The curveball is not to destroy you but to compel you
- Shut down the wrong response
- Abrahams response to the curveball was: "me and my son will go worship"
- God is looking for your worship. Worship is not measured by a song, feeling or emotion. It is based on trust, knowing that God is God
- God wants us to trust completely in Him not just lip service
- Our worship needs to be a worship that says "God, I depend on You, I respect You"
- You need to have a conviction that God is in control
- He has a good future in store for you and it will come because God is not a man that he should lie
- **When the curveball comes, God is looking for a certain response: your worship**
- **He is looking for a worship that is saying: "God I trust You"**
- He will do what he said He will do, because He is who He said He is
- Even if you do not trust yourself, you need to make sure that you trust Him
- There is a type of worship that activates the goodness of God

Psalms 31:19

Oh, how great is Your goodness, Which You have laid up for those who fear You, Which You have prepared for those who trust in You In the presence of the sons of men!

- Worship needs to be based on who God is, not on who you are
- He has a certain destination in store for you. God will intercept in your life. He has a greater future for you
- When you worship God He will not only intercept and change the road that you are walking on but He will intervene. Intervention has to do with the result
- God wants to change the outcome of your life. God's result is abundance and prosperity
- Do not try to work things out, shift your worship, don't worry how things will happen
- **Worship activates the goodness of God**
- It will shut down guilt and shame that is confining your worth
- He wants to bestow goodness over the lives of His sons and daughters
- Do not worry about the curveball
- Don't walk around the mountain

- He is looking for your worship
- No matter how bad you are he wants to release goodness and mercy
- The Word says: “Your goodness and mercy will follow me all the days of my life”
- Stop measuring the nature of God on where you are because you will always fall short
- Rise in your Spirit
- He wants to release heavenly goodness over our lives
- God is looking from a different kind of worship
- Worship from sincerity
