Matthew 18:20

For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them.”

- As we gather together in this place, our one purpose and desire should be to lift up the name of the Lord Jesus

Word

- God committed a flood in our lives and in our cities
- When God speaks and you take hold of that Word, implementing it in your life, you will be changed
- God wants to flood our lives
- A flood removes everything that is not from God
- It is the presence of the Lord that will bring the change

Isaiah 44:3-4

For I will pour water on the thirsty land and streams on the dry ground, I will pour out my Spirit on your offspring and my blessing on your descendants. They will spring up like grass in a meadow, like poplar trees by flowing streams.

- What qualifies us is our thirst
- God wants to pour out His Spirit on us but we need to be thirsty
- He will answer with His Word and Spirit
- God will push out darkness
- There will come a time that when the worship stops we will not stop
- Some of us are so dry from the lack of His presence but God wants to come and flood us
- We need to have a strong Spirit
- God wants to come and refresh us with His living water
- The flood of the Lord is going to push out limitations
- Let us open our hearts and let the river of God come

John 7:37-38

On the last and greatest day of the festival, Jesus stood and said in a loud voice, “Let anyone who is thirsty come to me and drink. Whoever believes in me, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow from within them.”

- When the Lord commits a word to the church we can get excited
- When God commits His Word He is ready to act, He will perform it
- The flood is the Church
- We have been called to carry living waters
- We need to understand why God has given us the living water
- The Word is alive
- Don't get used to your surrounding areas. God wants to do something fresh every day
- When the flood comes it comes with power
- We will be a force to be reckoned with
- The dream of God is not for us to have nice things, it is to touch lives
- The river of God wants to flow in the city
- We were not called to maintain or stagnate but to break out
- Why are we here? We need to confront these things in our lives

Isaiah 54:2-3

“Enlarge the place of your tent, stretch your tent curtains wide, do not hold back, lengthen your cords, strengthen your stakes. For you will spread out to the right and to the left, your descendants will dispossess nations and settle in their desolate cities.

- The church belongs to the Lord, not a man
- Just believe (It is an action)
- Where do you see yourself in ten years' time?
- God placed a calling on your life
- God is ready to act
- We need to bring the change
- We bring the change by taking up responsibility for what is already being done

Acts 17:24-28

The God who made the world and everything in it is the Lord of heaven and earth and does not live in temples built by human hands. And he is not served by human hands, as if he needed anything. Rather, he himself gives everyone life and breath and everything else. From one man he made all the nations, that they should inhabit the whole earth and he marked out their appointed times in history and the boundaries of their lands. God did this so that they would seek him and perhaps reach out for him and find him, though he is not far from any one of us. ‘For in him we live and move and have our being.’ As some of your own poets have said, ‘We are his offspring.’

- Do not get clouded with our daily living, it is temporary
- God has a plan with every person in your life
- If we accept the responsibility we will see a change in the city
- Use your platform that God has given you to serve Him and to be a light and a hope for others out there
- God predetermined a plan for every man. God's preappointed plan is to find Him. We are preappointed in this city just to be here to do something for God
- You do not need to be perfect, you just need to be thirsty
- It is not the responsibility of one individual
- Raise up people to stand for God
- A light will always confront the marketplace
- God Confronted, confrontation is not always negative

2 Corinthians 4:16-18

Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. So we fix our eyes not on what is seen but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary but what is unseen is eternal.

- What we have to give has eternal value
- We all have challenges but the Word says it light and for a short time
- Embrace every situation in your life

Romans 8:28-29

And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters.

- The struggles and sufferings are part of the life God gives, we need to start being transparent
- The world need to see that we handle our problems differently
- Do not wish your challenges away, you discover who God is in the troubles
- Allow God to do the work in you, do not cease to give your life to people

- The results do not belong to us
- We need to be serving all of the time
- What impact do we have in the area that you live?
- God gives you legal right in the city
- We need to stay fresh and become determined
- Germiston belongs to the Lord.
- Become bold in what you stand for
- God is sure on what he wants for the city
- Do not wait for an opportunity, take up the initiative
- We all have the ministry of reconciliation

2 Corinthians 5:16-19

So from now on we regard no one from a worldly point of view. Though we once regarded Christ in this way, we do so no longer. Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here! All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation.
